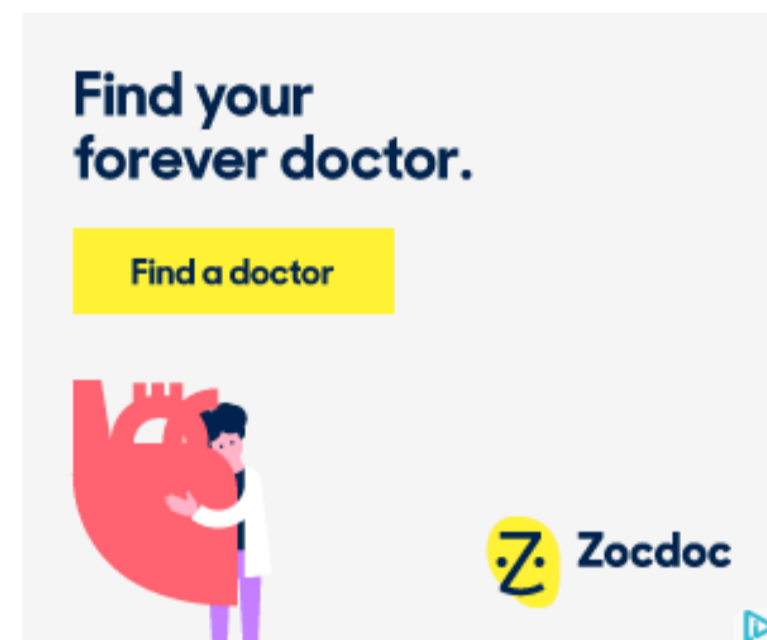


FitzGerald Fine Arts Debuts the Work of Hui Chi Lee
